The Danville Area Chamber of Commerce is pleased to announce the open scholarship program opportunity for our local students. The 2019 funding comes from dollars transferred from the Alamo Chamber of Commerce upon their consolidation with the DACC as well as our active fundraising events.

Our deadline to receive all completed applications is 5:00 pm, Friday, April 26. The recipients will be notified the week of May 20th.

Attached is one master application. The first page outlines the program and explains the requirements. The second page is the actual application. To be eligible, students must live in Danville, Alamo, Blackhawk or Diablo. They need to complete the application form, write two essays (about their community involvement, future goals and possible financial need) and send those along with copies of their grade transcripts for the past two years.

2019 SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION Danville Area Chamber of Commerce

PURPOSE

The Danville Area Chamber of Commerce is an organization dedicated to contributing time and programs to the economic growth of local businesses. With this mission, the Chamber has an annual program to give two \$1,000 scholarships to exemplary high school students; young citizens who will potentially be a part of the business community.

ELIGIBILITY

1. All local high school seniors who are planning to enroll full time in the fall of 2019 in an accredited trade or business school, community college, college or university are eligible.
2. Students must live in Danville, Alamo, Blackhawk or Diablo and attend one of the local High Schools (Athenian, Del Amigo, Monte Vista or San Ramon Valley High School).
3. These students display positive character and leadership skills, demonstrated by community involvement, extracurricular activities and their commitment to further their formal education to enter a trade, public service or the business world.
4. Students must have performed at least 40 hours of community service or volunteer work in the past two years with a non-profit, with seniors, children, religious organization, etc.

INFORMATION ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

- ▶ Danville Area Chamber scholarships will be given annually in amounts of \$1,000.
- ▶ Financial need is considered, but is not a necessary requirement.
- ▶ Scholarships may be used at the university, college, community college or trade school of the student's choice.
- ▶ A scholarship check will be mailed directly to student finalists in July after graduation.
- ▶ Applications are available at the Chamber office, website and in high school college guidance centers.
