Business Owner Pouring Instructions

Your Participation Fee covers the following services provided by the Danville Area Chamber of Commerce:

1. State of California Alcohol Beverage Control One Day Wine/Beer License. This license may be revoked summarily by the Department if, in the opinion of the Department and/or the local law enforcement agency, it is necessary to protect the safety, welfare, health, peace, and morals of the people of the State.
2. All guests will come with their tasting glass and a wristband which indicates they have paid and are over 21 years of age.
3. Post a **“No Alcohol Beyond This Point”** sign.

What YOU need to provide to set up for wine and beer tasters:

1. Small bites for guests (We encourage you to contact local restaurants to provide bites for cross-promotion)
2. Table for wine or beer, tablecloth, **ICE**, ice bucket and towel
3. Door monitor to see that the guests do not leave with alcohol in their glass
4. Bucket for people to pour unwanted wine or beer

Public Safety Requirements:

1. Vintners / Craft Breweries are to pour 1-oz pours only to those bearing the proper wristband for the Flavors of Fall event.
2. Do not leave alcohol unattended and do not let people pour their own alcohol.
3. Post **“No Alcohol Beyond This Point”** sign and assign a door monitor to check that guests do not leave premises with wine or beer in their glass.

The following are your final instructions and details:

1. The wineries and craft beer owners will bring their wine and / or beer on Saturday, October 22, 2022.
2. Tickets will be sold Online.

3. Wristbands will also be sold the day of the event by the Danville Area Chamber at this check-in location:
 - **Veterans Memorial Building – 400 Hartz Avenue, Danville**
4. Merchants will not be selling wristbands. Cost is **\$55** per person Online at Eventbrite through October 17th and **\$65** per person thereafter. Designated Drivers are **\$15** per person.
5. Commemorative tasting glasses and wristbands will be provided to all paid guests.
6. Pourers are to serve 1-oz. pours only to those wearing a wristband. The wristband confirms they have paid and are of legal age. One tasting per person.
7. All wine and beer must be consumed inside the business owner's store and you must post a "**No Alcohol Beyond This Point**" sign at your door so guests can easily read it before exiting.
