All Danville Municipal Parking Lots and the Community Presbyterian Church Parking Lot (222 West El Pintado Road) will be available during the event.

Road Closure and Event Schedule:

1:00 PM – Diablo Road, Lane 1 (eastbound lane furthest south - Bank of the West side) will close with a gradual cone barrier starting from east corner of Front Street to just past the Old Oak Tree.

4:00 PM – Road Closures

- **Diablo Road** - just east of the Old Oak Tree to the Clock Tower Plaza
- **Hartz Avenue** - Linda Mesa & Hartz to just before School Street & Hartz, including a soft close to Hartz Way
- **West Prospect** - Clock Tower Parking Lot entrance to East Prospect Avenue and Front Street
- **Front Street** - Diablo Road to Front Street Municipal Parking Lot

5:00 – 6:00 PM – Performers arrive to set up at various locations in Historic Downtown Danville

5:00 PM – **Old Oak Tree:** Holiday Classics sing-along with MVHS & SRVHS Chamber Singers and Danville Girls Chorus

5:00 – 7:00 PM – **Supervisor Candace Andersen Open House** at her office at 309 Diablo Road, Danville

6:15 PM – **Old Oak Tree:** Tree Lighting Ceremony with Danville Mayor Robert Storer, Father Christmas & the Snow Angel

6:30 PM – **Entertainment begins throughout Historic Downtown Danville**

6:35 PM – **Oak Tree to Downtown Danville:** Father Christmas, the Snow Angel, and Next Step Dance Studio will proceed downtown, after photos on site. Families enjoy entertainment and refreshments along Hartz Avenue, Downtown Danville.

7:30 PM – Diablo Road re-opens

8:00 PM – Event Concludes

8:30 PM – All roads re-open
