PUBLIC SERVICE

Lloyd began her public service career in 1983, serving a U.S. Congressman from her home state of New York. She had the honor of serving as special assistant to U.S. Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole (1988-1992), where she orchestrated the appointment of the first person with a disability to the U.S. Civil Rights Commission.

Lloyd served as an appointee of two U.S. Presidents at the U.S. Departments of Agriculture (1985-1986) and Labor (2001-2006), acting as a liaison for congressional and intergovernmental affairs.

She was the first woman appointed by a U.S. President to serve as Western Region IX Representative for the U.S. Secretary of Labor, earning the Exceptional Achievement Award in 2004. She earned the *San Francisco Business Times* Women of Distinction Award in Politics & Government in 2003.

From 2015-2020, Lloyd represented the communities of Alamo, Danville, Diablo, and San Ramon as senior district representative for Senator Steve Glazer. She managed and improved the TRAFFIX Bus Program (2016-2018) under a joint powers' authority for schools in the San Ramon Valley Unified School District.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

Lloyd is an active community volunteer who strongly supports first responders, public safety and our nation's veterans. She serves as Vice President of the Exchange Club of the San Ramon Valley and as a Board Member at the https://exchange-club.com/Three-Valleys-Community-Foundation.

She is an active member of the <u>Contra Costa Sheriff's Posse</u>, the <u>Museum of the San Ramon Valley</u>, the <u>Italian Catholic Federation</u>, the <u>National Federation of Independent Business</u>, and the <u>Danville Area Chamber of Commerce</u>. She has served as a leader and advocate for pancreatic cancer research, traveling to Washington, D.C. to advocate before the Speaker of the U.S. House and congressional leadership.

A longtime advocate for business, Lloyd owns <u>Altamont Strategies</u>, a small business in Contra Costa County. She serves on the NFIB California Leadership Council, chairing the NFIB State PAC in 2022. She served as a Visiting Fellow at the Dole Institute of Politics, University of Kansas (2015), running a 6-week series on extraordinary women in politics and business. In 2020, she was inducted into the Contra Costa Women's Hall of Fame. She started the <u>Women's Enterprise Initiative</u>, a leadership training program at the Danville Area Chamber of Commerce in 2024.
